And now Slide Thru, Touch 1/4, Girl Run Right. Corner Swing, Swing a little lady, boy, and Promenade that ring. I miss my old home town; no place I'd rather be, Than walking on the back roads in the hills of Tennessee.

# MIDDLE BREAK

Circle now.

The city wasn't friendly to a country boy like me. The town that I had dreamed of was just a fantasy. Left Allemande, now Turn the partner by the Right. Left Allemande that corner lady, Weave around tonight. The Tennessee backroads in the shadow of the pine. Swing a little lady 'round and Promenade in time. I long for that old dirt road; that's where I want to be. Not growing up in a holler in the hills of Tennessee.

# CLOSER

Circle now

Packed up my suitcase and packed up my pride. I'm drivin' my old pickup down the mountain side. Left Allemande, now Turn the partner by the Right. Left Allemande that corner lady, Weave around tonight. The Tennessee backroads in the shadow of the pine. Swing a little lady 'round and Promenade in time. When I see my mama, I'll tell her I was wrong. I'm headed back to Dixie, the place where I belong.
