OPENER

Circle Left. Dirt road in the twilight, woods so cool and dark, Up ahead pale neon, somewhere a dog barks.

Left Allemande the corner, Turn your partner Right hand around. Allemande Left and Weave the land.

Breaking up the pool balls, chalking up the cues.

Swing and Promenade to the lazy summer blues.

Honky tonk moon keeps shinin' on my baby and me.

FIGURE

Heads [sides] Square Thru from where you are. Meet the sides [heads], you make a Right Hand Star. Heads [sides] Star Left inside the land. Find the corner, do a Do Sa Do, make a wave. Linear Cycle, go all the way through. Slide Thru, take the girl and Promenade her, too. Honky tonk moon keeps shinin' on my baby and me.

MIDDLE BREAK

Circle Left. My arms around my baby, shuffling on the floor.
Cigarettes and sawdust, squeaky old screen door.
Left Allemande the corner, Turn your partner Right hand around.
Allemande Left and Weave the land.
Outside the dark has fallen, stars are winking bright.
Swing and Promenade, everything's all right.
Honky tonk moon keeps shinin' on my baby and me.

CLOSER

Head Ladies Center, Tea Cup Chain.
Dirt road in the twilight, woods so cool and dark.
Up ahead pale neon, somewhere a dog barks.
Honky tonk moon keeps shinin' on my baby and me.
Allemande and Weave.
Breaking up the pool balls, chalking up the cues.
Jukebox pumping softly, lazy summer blues.
