Circle Left.

Come back and Do Sa Do, Allemande Left again, Weave the ring along the lane. Lemon tree very pretty, and the lemon flower is sweet. Swing your girl, pretty little taw. Promenade, go 'round, you know. Lemon tree very pretty, and the lemon flower is sweet. But the fruit of the poor lemon is impossible to eat.

FIGURE

Head [side] couples Promenade half way 'round the cave. Down the middle Dixie Style to an ocean wave. Center Boys Trade, all Extend. Left Swing Thru, Girls Run Left, Bend the Line. Flutter Wheel across and Slide Thru. Swing your corner girl and Promenade the ring. Lemon tree very pretty, and the lemon flower is sweet. But the fruit of the poor lemon is impossible to eat.

BREAK

Circle Left. One day beneath the lemon tree, my love and I did lie. A girl so sweet that when she smiled the stars rose in the sky. *Continue as in Opener*.

ENDING

Circle Left. One day she left without a word; she took away the sun. And in the dark she left behind, I knew what she had done. *Continue as in Opener.*

TAG

But the fruit of the poor lemon is impossible to eat.
