Heads [sides] Lead to the Right, Circle to a Line.

Right and Left Thru, turn your girl, Dixie Style to a wave.
Girls Circulate, Boys Trade, Recycle here.
Veer to the Right, Bend the Line, Slide Thru, Swing and Promenade.
Don't be cruel to a heart that's true.

MIDDLE BREAK:

Sides Face, Grand Square. You know I can be found sittin' home all alone. If you can't come around, at least please telephone. Four Ladies Promenade inside, come back Swing and Promenade. Don't be cruel to a heart that's true.

CLOSER:

Sides Face, Grand Square.
Baby if I made you mad for something I might have said,
Please let's forget the past, the future looks bright ahead.
Four ladies promenade inside, come back Swing and Promenade.
Don't be cruel to a heart that's true.

TAG:

Four Ladies Chain across and Chain 'em back home. Don't be cruel to a heart that's true.
