Circle Left.

Left Allemande and do a Dosado, Allemande Left and Weave the ring. Watch the curves and heed the tunnels.

Swing and all Promenade. (Never falter, never fail.)

Keep your hand upon the throttle, and your eyes upon the rail.

Figure:

Heads Promenade go halfway, Walk in and Square Thru go four.

All the way and then do a Pass the Ocean by the right hand.

Cast off 3/4 around, Boys Run, Pass Thru, Trade By.

Corner Swing and you Promenade.

Where the angels wait to join us in that great forever more.

Middle Break:

Sides Face, Grand Square.

As you roll across the trestle, spanning Jordan's swelling tide.

You behold the Union Depot, into which your train will glide. Allemande and weave.

There you'll meet the superintendent, God the father, God the son.

With a hearty join us plaudit, weary pilgrim, welcome home.

Closer:

Four Ladies Chain across, turn the girl.

Four Ladies Chain her back, turn'em around.

All join your hands, Circle Left go 'round, Allemande Left and Weave the ring. Watch the curves, heed the tunnels. Never falter, never fail.

Keep your hand upon the throttle.

And your eyes upon the rail.
