---------	---	-----------	--

BASIC LEVEL I

INTRO: Wait 16 beats

DANCE SEQUENCE:

(16)	4	Step Vine Brush	&St(s)-&St(xb)-&St(s)-Kick (clap) <i>Side – Behind – Side - Kick</i>
(8)	2	Rock Forward	&St-RS-RS-RS; move forward <i>and Step – Rock Step – Rock Step – Rock Step</i>
(8)	4	Two Steps; roll	&St-RS; turn 3/4 R to face new wall <i>and Step – Rock Step</i>

Repeat entire dance to face a new wall each time.
Sequence goes through 6 times.

BASIC LEVEL II

INTRO: Wait 16 beats

DANCE SEQUENCE:

(16)	4	Vine Brush	DS(s)-DS(xb)-DS(s)-BrSl <i>Dbl Side – Dbl Behind – Dbl Side – Brush Up</i>
(8)	2	Rock Forward	DS-RS-RS-RS; move forward <i>Dbl Step – Rock Step – Rock Step – Rock Step</i>
(8)	4	Basics; roll	DS-RS; turn 3/4 R to face new wall <i>Double Step – Rock Step</i>

ABBREVIATIONS:

St = Step
Br = Brush
s = side

RS = Rock Step
Sl = Slide
xb = cross in back

D = Double Toe
R = right

OTHER ALTERATIONS

As dancers learn other 4-count steps, they can be used to replace the Vine Brush. Good possibilities are: Side Rocks, Vines, Rocker Right & Left, Slur Vine, Slur Vine Brush, Hillbilly, etc.

The Rock Forward can be replaced by a Rock Back to vary it, also.
