INTRO: Wait 8 beats
(4) 2 Brushes

DS-BrSl

PART A: (Chorus)

(4) - 2 Slur Steps
(4) 2 - 1 Triple

DS-SlurSt(xb)
DS-DS-DS-RS

Bridge:

(4) 2 Basics

DS-RS

PART B1: (Verse)

(16) 4 Brush & Turns

DS-BrSl(1/4 L)-DS-RS

Repeat Part A

PART C:

(8) 2 Turning Cowboys

DS-DS-DS-BrSl(1/2 L)-DS-RS-RS-RS;
go forward, turn 1/2 L, then back up

Repeat Bridge (2 Basics)

PART B2:

(8) - 2 Brush & Turns
(8) 2 2 Triples
(4) - 4 Toe Heels

end facing the back
ToH

PART A2:

(4) 2 Slur Steps
(4) 1 Triple
(4) 2 Slur Steps
(3) 3 Runs
(8) 8 Toe Heels; roll

to L
to R
DS
full turn L

Repeat Part C

Repeat Part A twice, but turn 1/4 L on each Triple to make a box.

Repeat Part C

Repeat Part A twice, but turn 1/4 L on each Triple to make a box. (Stomp on last RS.)

Abbreviations:

Dt = DoubleToe
Sl = Slide
Br = Brush
L = left

DS = DT-Step
S or St = Step
To = Toe
R = right

RS = Rock-Step
H = Heel
Rk = Rock
xb = cross in back
