Star Promenade your partner, and take them home my friend
There's treasure for the taking, for any hard working man
Who will make his home in the American land.

MIDDLE BREAK:

(To your left Single File, go.)
McNicholas', Posalski's, the Smith's, Zerillis' too
The Africans, the Irish, Germans, and Jews. Reverse.
The Mexicans, Italians, and the Asians choose
To make their home... Join Hands and Circle Left.

CLOSER:

(To your left Single File, go.)
They worked building railroads, worked to bones and skin
They worked in the fields, and the factories. Reverse.
Yes they worked to get here, a hundred years ago
They made their home... Join Hands and Circle Left.

TAG: Yes they made their home in the American Land.
